SUMMARY:

House Bill 1929, Printer's Number 2722 amends Section 1754-A.1 (c) (Use of fund) of The Fiscal Code of 1929 (P.L. 343, No.176) further providing for the use of funds by the First Chance Fund.

ANALYSIS:

HB 1929 amends Section 1754-A.1 (c) by requiring the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency (PCCD) to allocate revenues in the First Chance Trust Fund for the purpose of establishing and operating a scholarship program, providing grants and programs for students and children who reside in those regions of the Commonwealth with statistically higher high school dropout rates, incarceration rates or high crime rates as determined by PCCD and who have been a victim of a violent crime or whose parent or guardian was a victim of a homicide or other violent crime.

This legislation will take effect in 60 days.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds. The Department of Corrections anticipates that the Trust Fund will generate \$500,000 to \$1,000,000 on an annual basis.
