SUMMARY: House Bill 1936, Printer's Number 4275, amends Title 75 to make editorial and reference changes related to highway and bridge restrictions and all-terrain vehicles.

ANALYSIS: This bill amends Sections 4902(A)(4) and (5), 7725(B.1) and 7743 (A) of Title 75 (Vehicles) to make some editorial and technical reference changes related to restrictions on the use of highways and bridges and to the Snowmobile and All-Terrain Vehicle Law.

Section 4902(A)(4) and (5) is amended with additional language to extend the sunset date of weight and size exemptions for logging and other forest product vehicles. It extends the date by five years from December 31, 2018 to December 31, 2023, so that exemptions and related requirements remain.

The term "or its successor standard" is added to the requirement of Section 7725 addressing size restrictions, specifically that all-terrain vehicles are not operated in violation of the vehicle's age recommendation label conforming to ANSI/SVIA 1-2010.

It also changes all references of "noise" to "sound" in Section 7743 related to mufflers and sound control, while also changing "ANSI/SAE" to "SAE" in reference to what is cited in the law.

This legislation would take effect immediately upon enactment.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this bill will have no fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
