SUMMARY: Amends Title 74 (Transportation Code) to clarify the scenic road designation for the National Road in Southwestern Pennsylvania. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends the Transportation Code to clarify the sections of U.S. Route 40 that are included in the previously designated scenic road and other nearby roads that make up the former National Road.

The legislation clarifies legislative intent to designate the original National Road and not any rerouted portion of U.S. Route 40.

The sections include portions of the current U.S. Route 40 in Somerset, Fayette and Washington Counties as well as U.S. Business Route 40, State Route 2040, S.R. 8008, S.R. 8002, S.R. 2067, S.R. 4035, S.R. 4025, S.R. 2089, S.R. 2048, S.R. 1083, S.R. 3010, S.R. 3024, S.R. 3023 and Main Street in Addison Borough and Addison Township in Somerset County.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
