**SUMMARY:** Designates multiple highways and a bridge in the Commonwealth. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation makes the following traffic designations:

- Section 1 designates the section of PA Route 73, also known as Cottman Avenue, between U.S. Route 13 and U.S. Route 1 in the City of Philadelphia, Philadelphia County, as the Police Officer Isabel Nazario Memorial Highway.
- Section 2 designates the section of PA Route 29 in Montgomery County from PA Route 663 to Tollgate Road as the Leonard Joseph Taglieber Memorial Highway.
- Section 3 designates a portion of PA Route 41 (Gap Newport Pike) between PA Route 926 (Street Road) and U.S. Route 1 located in London Grove Township and Londonderry Township, Chester County, as the Trooper Kenton Iwaniec Memorial Highway.
- Section 4 designates the section of SR 2019, known as Garrett Road, in Delaware County from Burmont Road to N. Lansdowne Avenue as the Deputy Chief Michael P. Morgan Memorial Highway.
- Section 5 designate the section of SR 115 from Long Pond Road in Tunkhannock Township, Monroe County, to State Road/Jonas Road in Chestnuthill Township, Monroe County, as the Submarine Veterans Memorial Highway.
- Section 6 designates the bridge located on SR 954 over the North Branch of Plum Creek, South Mahoning Township, Indiana County, as the PFC William T. Bresnock Memorial Bridge.

PennDOT must erect and maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway or bridge to traffic in both directions on the highway or bridge.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. Since there are 6 designations, the total cost would be \$3,000. That cost can be absorbed utilizing existing appropriations.
