#### SUMMARY:

House Bill 2215 amends the Public School Code concerning fire and emergency evacuation drills. It would take effect in 60 days.

#### ANALYSIS:

Under current law, school entities are permitted, but not required, to conduct one school security drill per school year in each school building in place of a required fire drill. House Bill 2215 would make this security drill a requirement. It would also permit, but not require, school entities to conduct two additional school security drills per school year in each school building in place of two required fire drills.

#### FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
