SUMMARY:

House Bill 2242 appropriates funding for the Pennsylvania State University. It would take effect on July 1, 2018 or immediately, whichever is later.

ANALYSIS:

This legislation appropriates funds to the Pennsylvania State University for the 2018-19 fiscal year. The appropriation for General Support receives \$237,349,000, an increase of \$6,913,000, or 3%, over the amount received in 2017-18. The appropriation for the Pennsylvania College of Technology receives \$22,736,000, an increase of \$662,000, or 3%, over the amount received in 2017-18. The bill also authorizes the appropriation of money contained within the Agricultural College Land Scrip Fund restricted receipt account for Agriculture Research and Extension Services. Funds provided for this account are appropriated as part of the General Appropriations Act.

FISCAL IMPACT:

A total amount of \$260,085,000 is provided in the following appropriations:

- For General Support, \$237,349,000;
- For Pennsylvania College of Technology, \$22,736,000.
