SUMMARY: House Bill 2246 appropriates funding for the University of Pennsylvania for veterinary activities and infectious disease research. It would take effect July 1, 2018, or immediately, whichever is later.

ANALYSIS: This legislation appropriates funds to the University of Pennsylvania for the 2018-19 fiscal year. The appropriation for Veterinary Activities receives \$31,039,000, an increase of \$904,000, or 3%, over the amount appropriated for the 2017-18 fiscal year. The appropriation for the Center for Infectious Diseases receives \$289,000, an increase of \$8,000, or 2.8%, over the amount appropriated for the 2017-18 fiscal year.

FISCAL IMPACT: A total amount of \$31,328,000 is provided to the University of Pennsylvania in the following appropriations:

- for Veterinary Activities, \$31,039,000;
- for the Center for Infectious Diseases, \$289,000.
