SUMMARY: Designates a bridge on a portion of S.R. 286 in Indiana and Westmoreland Counties as the First Sergeant Alexander Kelly Memorial Bridge. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates a portion of S.R. 286, known as Washington Street over the Kiskiminetas River between Saltsburg Borough in Indiana County and Loyalhanna Township in Westmoreland County as the First Sergeant Alexander Kelly Memorial Bridge.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying this designation to traffic in both directions.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
