SUMMARY:

House Bill 2489, Printer's Number 3691, authorizes the release of Project 70 land use restrictions on a parcel of land in the Borough of Topton, Berks County in exchange for the imposition of Project 70 restrictions on a parcel of land to be acquired by the borough.

ANALYSIS:

This legislation authorizes the release of Project 70 Land Acquisition and Borrowing Act land use restrictions on a 1,930 square foot parcel of land in the Borough of Topton, Berks County, which is owned by the borough. The bill provides for the release of these restrictions in exchange for the imposition of Project 70 restrictions, specifically for recreation, conservation and historical purposes, on a 6,863 square foot parcel of land to be acquired by the borough.

The effective date of this legislation is immediately upon enactment.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation will have no fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
