SUMMARY: Designates multiple bridges throughout the Commonwealth. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates multiple bridges throughout the Commonwealth as follows:

- Section 1 designates the bridge located on old State Route 22 that connects Blairsville Borough, Indiana County, and Derry Township, Westmoreland County, over the Conemaugh River as the Blairsville Area Veterans Memorial Bridge.
- Section 2 designates the bridge located on that portion of State Route 4027, also known as Business U.S. Route 220, over the Norfolk Southern Mainline Railroad tracks in Grazierville, Snyder Township, Blair County, as the John Frederick Bridges Memorial Bridge.
- Section 3 designates the bridge, identified as Bridge Key 53825, located on that portion of State Route 1011, also known as Castile Run Road, over the South Fork Tenmile Creek between Jefferson Township and Clarksville Borough, Greene County, as the PFC Brent A. McClellan Memorial Bridge.
- Section 4 designates the bridge located on that portion of U.S. Route 11 over the Susquehanna River between the City of Pittston and West Pittston Borough, Luzerne County, as the Specialist Dale J. Kridlo Memorial Bridge.
- Section 5 designates the bridge located at the junction of State Route 150 and State Route 64 over Fishing Creek in Mill Hall Borough, Clinton County, as the U.S. Navy SOC David M. Collins Veterans Memorial Bridge.
- Section 6 designates the bridge located on State Route 2014 over Lycoming Creek, City of Williamsport, Lycoming County, as the Alexander M. McFadden Memorial Bridge.

- Section 7 designates the bridge located on State Route 85 over the north branch of Plum Creek in Plumville Borough, Indiana County, as the Henry Lue Weaver Memorial Bridge.
- Section 8 designates the bridge located on State Route 26 in Howard Township, Centre County, over Bald Eagle Creek, as the Howard Area Veterans Bridge.

PennDOT shall erect and maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridges to traffic in both directions on the bridges.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. Since there are 8 designations within this legislation, the cost will be roughly \$4,000. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
