**SUMMARY:** Amends the Second Class Township Code to allow second class township supervisors to hold certain appointed positions. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation amends Section 403(b) to provide that a second class township supervisor may hold other appointed positions within the township, as long as the appointment is not otherwise prohibited by this act or by statute. The act does not prohibit second class township supervisors from being members of the township planning commission. However, a second class township supervisor is still prohibited from holding any other elective township position at the same time under this act.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth or second class township funds.
