**SUMMARY:** Senate Bill 646, Printer's Number 1052, amends the Municipal Waste Planning, Recycling and Waste Reduction Act to extend the sunset date for the recycling fee for municipal waste landfills and resource recovery facilities by one year.

**ANALYSIS:** This bill amends the Municipal Waste Planning, Recycling and Waste Reduction Act (act 101 of 1988) to extend the sunset date for the recycling fee for municipal waste landfills and resource recovery facilities by one year. The fee's sunset provision is extended from January 1, 2020 to January 1, 2021.

The bill also eliminates transfer language stating that all moneys in the Recycling Fund that are not expended shall be transferred to the Solid Waste Abatement Fund.

This legislation would take effect in 60 days upon enactment.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** Enactment of this bill will have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds. Extending the recycling fee for municipal waste landfills and resource recovery facilities another year until January 1, 2021 ensures additional money will be available in the Recycling Fund for expenditure. The \$2 per ton recycling fee generates approximately \$38 million in annual revenue for the Recycling Fund.
