SUMMARY: Permits second class townships to purchase used personal property from volunteer emergency service organizations without bid. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends the Second Class Township Code (Act 69 of 1933) to allow purchase, without going through the bidding process, of used equipment, articles, apparatus, appliances, vehicles or parts of vehicles, or any other personal property from a volunteer fire company, volunteer ambulance service, or a volunteer rescue squad.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would allow second class townships to realize savings from lower market value prices agreed to between municipalities and volunteer emergency service organizations. It is also anticipated that municipalities will save the advertising and administrative costs associated with preparing a notice for requests for bids. This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
