SUMMARY: Amends the open meetings requirements in the Sunshine Act to allow an additional use of executive sessions, where deemed necessary for emergency preparedness, public safety, or security of property. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends the Sunshine Act to allow an agency to hold an executive session to discuss, plan or review matters and records that are deemed necessary for emergency preparedness, protection of public safety and security of all property in a manner that, if disclosed, would be reasonably likely to jeopardize public safety or preparedness or public protection.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth or political subdivision funds.
