SUMMARY: Abolishes various outdated boards, commissions, committees and other entities established by law and makes related repeals. This legislation would take effect 60 days after enactment.

ANALYSIS: This legislation abolishes the following entities and makes related repeals:

- The Advisory Committee on Probation within the PA Board of Probation and Parole.
- The Industrial Resource Center Strategic Advisory Board within the Department of Community and Economic Development.
- The joint committee to review cost-of-living supplements under the SERS and PSERS Acts.
- The PA Public Television Network Commission.
- The Public Television Broadcasting Advisory Council.
- The PA Quality Leadership Awards Council.
- The Small Business Advocacy Council within the Department of Community and Economic Development.
- The Tobacco Use Prevention and Cessation Advisory Committee within the Department of Health.
- The legislative representative for collective bargaining appointed under 71 Pa.C.S. § 2205.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
