SUMMARY: Authorizes the state professional and occupational licensing boards to allow carryover of excess continuing education credits. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends the Bureau of Professional and Occupational Affairs Act (Act 48 of 1993) to authorize the licensing boards under the Department of State's Bureau of Professional and Occupational Affairs (BPOA) to allow licensees who earn continuing education (CE) credits in excess of the amount required for license renewal to carryover the excess and apply them to the next biennial renewal period.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
