SUMMARY: Authorizes students in physical therapy and physical therapy assistant educational programs to sit for their licensure/certification examination up to 90 days prior to graduation. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends the Physical Therapy Practice Act (Act 110 of 1975) to allow students to take the examination required for licensure as a physical therapist (PT) or certification as a physical therapist assistant (PTA) up to 90 days prior to graduation from their educational programs.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds
