**SUMMARY**: Sets the minimum threshold for vehicles with light-emitting diodes (LEDs) headlights/taillights to pass an annual safety inspection. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS**: This legislation amends Title 75 (Vehicle Code) to require vehicles using LED headlights or taillights to have at least 50% of the LEDs emit light to pass a safety inspection. It also requires that a vehicle using LED lights in a vehicle's head or tail lamp, except off road lighting, must light properly, which is 50% of the LEDs emitting light.

**FISCAL IMPACT**: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
