SUMMARY:

House Bill 387, Printer's Number 371, authorizes the release of Project 70 land use restrictions on 4 parcels of land in Upper Uwchlan Township, Chester County, in exchange for the imposition of Project 70 restrictions on a five-acre parcel of land in Wallace Township, Chester County.

ANALYSIS:

This legislation authorizes the release of Project 70 Land Acquisition and Borrowing Act land use restrictions on four parcels of land owned by the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (DCNR) totaling 4.3 acres located in Upper Uwchlan Township, Chester County. These parcels are to be acquired by the Turnpike Commission, in exchange for the imposition of Project 70 restrictions on a five-acre parcel of land in Wallace Township, Chester County. The commission owns a five-acre mitigation area that will be acquired by DCNR and included as part of Marsh Creek State Park.

The effective date of this legislation is immediately upon enactment.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation will have no impact on Commonwealth funds.
