SUMMARY: Amends the Third Class City Code to delete the phrase “by ordinance” from the provisions governing intergovernmental cooperation agreements. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation removes the phrase “by ordinance” in Section 12434 (b) of the Third Class City Code. This change will enable Third Class Cities to enter into intergovernmental cooperation agreements pursuant to the provisions in Title 53 Chapter 23 Subchapter A (relating to intergovernmental cooperation).

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth or third class city funds.
