#### SUMMARY:

House Bill 561, printer's number 560, amends the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L. 90, No. 21), known as the Liquor Code, to further provide for unlawful acts relative to liquor, malt or brewed beverages and licensees.

The effective date is 60 days after enactment.

#### ANALYSIS:

The bill amends Section 493 (13) of the Liquor Code (relating to Retail Licensees Employing Minors) to allow a hotel, restaurant or club licensee to permit a minor of any age to perform music on the licensed premises if the minor is not compensated, and the minor is under the supervision of a parent or guardian.

#### FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
