SUMMARY: House Bill 918, Printer's Number 2278, repeals an outdated appropriation from the State Treasury in aid of the Farmers' High School.

ANALYSIS: This bill repeals Act 658 of 1857 making a \$25,000 appropriation from the State Treasury in aid of the Farmers' High School with the admission of pupils, an office for soil analysis, and experiment reporting. The Farmers' High School became The Pennsylvania State University. Penn State currently receives state funding via non-preferred appropriations legislation amending Act 227 of 1863.

This legislation would take effect in 60 days upon enactment.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation will have no impact on Commonwealth funds. Repealing this act does not impact the current operation and funding of Penn State University.
