SUMMARY: House Bill 1024, Printer's Number 2018, amends Article XXIII-A, Powers and Duties of the Department of Drug and Alcohol Programs in the Administrative Code. This legislation is effective in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: HB 1024 amends Section 2301-A (1) (xviii) to add language that the standards that relevant state agencies must apply when approving public and private treatment and rehabilitative facilities shall require that the public and private treatment and rehabilitative facilities may not deny addiction treatment to an individual solely due to a negative drug test.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds. The Department of Drug and Alcohol Programs does not currently require a positive drug test for an individual to receive treatment. The Department of Human Services also indicates no adverse fiscal impact from HB 1024.
