SUMMARY:

House Bill 1031 makes two repeals related to the Scotland School for Veterans' Children. It would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

The Scotland School for Veterans' Children was a state-owned school that provided residential education programs for free to the children of Pennsylvania residents who were veterans or who were currently serving in the United State armed forces. The school was closed in 2009 and its property sold in 2013. House Bill 1031 repeals two laws related to the School that are obsolete and no longer needed since the School no longer exists.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
