SUMMARY: House Bill 1086, Printer's Number 1258, repeals the act of June 5, 1937 (P.L. 1656, NO. 344).

ANALYSIS: This legislation repeals Act 344 of 1937 which requires Pennsylvania stores and theatres to pay an annual license tax that was declared unconstitutional by the Pennsylvania Supreme Court in 1939.

The act shall take effect in 60 days.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
