SUMMARY:

House Bill 1279, Printer's Number 3058, amends the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L. 90, No. 21), known as the Liquor Code, to further provide for wine expanded permits.

The act shall take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

The legislation amends Section 415 of the Liquor Code to increase the quantity of wine that may be sold by a wine expanded permit holder in a single transaction. The bill increases the quantity of wine that may be sold for off-premise consumption in a single transaction from 3,000 milliliters (4 bottles) to 9,000 milliliters (12 bottles).

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds and may increase revenue for the Commonwealth to the extent greater quantities of wine are sold annually.
