SUMMARY: Repeals the Sunday Sports Law which prohibits the playing of football and baseball during certain hours of the day on Sunday. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation repeals Act 192 of 1959 which allows for baseball and football games played on Sunday to be extended beyond 5:00 p.m. in municipalities that have approved the play of these sports under Act 49 of 1933 on that day. Act 49 of 1933 requires that baseball and football games played on Sunday can only be played between the hours of 2:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. It further provides that the voters of the municipality must approve the playing of baseball and football games on Sunday between the hours of 2:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth or municipal funds.
