SUMMARY:

House Bill 1457 amends the Insurance Company Law of 1921 concerning mastectomy and breast cancer reconstruction. It would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

Currently in the Insurance Company Law of 1921 under the section concerning mastectomy and breast cancer reconstruction, the term "prosthetic device" means the use of initial and subsequent artificial devices to replace the removed breast or portions thereof pursuant to an order of the patient's physician. House Bill 1457 adds language to clarify that this includes "custom artificial devices."

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
