**SUMMARY:** Designates multiple highways, bridges, interchanges and exits throughout the Commonwealth. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation makes the following traffic designations:

- A portion of S.R. 183 from Segment 0040/Offset 255 to Segment 110/Offset 1180 in Berks County as the Trooper Wayne Memorial Highway
- A bridge on S.R. 2087 in York County as the Corporal Michael Cohen Memorial Bridge
- A portion of SR 50 in Washington County as the Corporal Brady Clement Paul Memorial Highway
- The Morgan Road Bridge over Interstate 79 in Washington County as the Wreathes Across America Bridge
- The Interstate 70, Exit 17, in Washington County as the Sergeant Russel Crupe, JR. Memorial Exit
- A Bridge on North Main Street over the East Branch Perkiomen Creek in Bucks County as the Sellersville Veterans Memorial Bridge
- A portion of S.R. 39 in Dauphin County as the Officer Mark Gaspich Memorial Highway
- A bridge on U.S. Route 219 in Clearfield County as the Lance Corporal Robert Clyde Gontero Memorial Bridge
- A bridge on a portion of S.R. 3012 in Franklin County as the Sergeant Melvin G. Ehrhart Memorial Bridge
- A bridge on a portion of S.R. 8042 over U.S. Route 40 in Washington County as the SFC Thomas McDonough Memorial Bridge
- A bridge on S.R. 2003 in Greene County as the Sheriff Brian A. Tennant Memorial Bridge
- The Interchange of S.R. 43 with U.S. Route 40 in Fayette County as the PFC Joseph Frank Duda Memorial Interchange
- The Interchange of U.S. Route 40 with S.R. 4035 in Fayette County as the Corporal Denny Ray Easter Memorial Interchange

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying these designations to traffic in both directions.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** According to PennDOT, installation of two signs, one in each direction, dedicating a highway, bridge, interchange or exit costs \$500. Since there are 13 designations within this legislation, the total cost would be roughly \$6,500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
