SUMMARY: Designates the highway interchange of U.S. Route 422 with S.R. 66 in Armstrong County as the Senator Donald C. White Interchange. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates the highway interchange of U.S. Route 422 with S.R. 66 in Manor Township, Armstrong County as the Senator Donald C. White Interchange.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying this Designation to traffic in both directions.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of two signs, one in each direction, dedicating a bridge, highway, or interchange costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
