SUMMARY: Designates the highway interchange of U.S. Route 222 with Mohns Hill Road in Berks County as the Corporal Mahlon L. Fink Iwo Jima Memorial Highway Interchange. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates the highway interchange of U.S. Route 222 with Mohns Hill Road in Cumru Township in Berks County as the Corporal Mahlon L. Fink Iwo Jima Memorial Highway Interchange.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying this Designation to traffic in both directions.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge, highway or interchange costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
