**SUMMARY:** Designates multiple interchanges, highways, and bridges throughout the Commonwealth. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation designates the following:

- The highway interchange of U.S. Route 222 with Mohns Hill Road in Berks County as the Corporal Mahlon L. Fink Iwo Jima Memorial Highway Interchange
- A portion of S.R. 1015 between S.R. 63 and U.S. Route 13 in the City of Philadelphia as the Sergeant James O'Connor IV Memorial Bridge
- A bridge carrying S.R. 1036 over Six Mile Run in Bedford County as the Sergeant David Leon Barber Memorial Bridge
- A bridge on S.R. 4027 over Bald Eagle Creek in Blair County as the Corporal Donald L. Westley Memorial Bridge
- A bridge on a portion of PA Route 669 in Somerset County as the Sergeant Stephen M. Minick Memorial Bridge
- A bridge on a portion of S.R. 2004 in Somerset County as the Airman Michael L. Menser Memorial Bridge
- A bridge on a portion of S.R. 2025 in Delaware County as the Captain Michael Malinowski, SR., Memorial Bridge
- A portion of S.R. 2012 in Monroe County as the Reverend Dr. Bishop William Earl Lee Highway
- A bridge on I-70 in Westmoreland County as the Matthew Smelser Memorial Bridge
- A portion of County Line Road in Bucks County as the Captain William J. Ahlum Memorial Highway
- A portion of County Line Road in Bucks County as the Specialist 4 Harold E. Cashman Memorial Highway

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying these designations to traffic in both directions.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge, highway or interchange costs \$500. Since there are 12 sets of designations (Sergeant James O'Connor IV Memorial Bridge would have 4 signs total) within this legislation, this legislation would cost \$6,000. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
