**SUMMARY:** Amends Title 75 (Vehicle Code) to authorize PennDOT to issue a special registration plate for recipients of the Navy and Marine Corps Medal. This legislation would take effect in 120 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation adds a new Section 1366.2. (Special plates for recipients of Navy and Marine Corps Medal) to the Vehicle Code to authorize a new registration plate for recipients of the Navy and Marine Corps Medal. The plate will cost a \$22 fee, which shall be in addition to the registration fee, along with documentation required by PennDOT.

The Navy and Marine Corps license plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight of not more than 14,000 pounds.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** According to PennDOT, each new registration plate will cost \$500 for the design and \$14,500 for systems changes for a total of \$15,000. It is likely that most, if not all, of this cost would be offset by the revenue from the sale of such plates. In the event that revenues do not exceed costs, the remaining cost could be absorbed within available funding.
