**SUMMARY:** House Bill 1780, Printer's Number 2370, exempts volunteer EMS, fire or rescue companies from the Right-to-Know Law.

**ANALYSIS:** This bill amends Title 35 (Health and Safety) by inserting a new section providing for an exemption from the provisions of the Pennsylvania Right-to-Know Law (Act 3 of 2008), specifically for volunteer ambulance or emergency medical services, fire and rescue companies as defined under Section 7802.

This legislation would take effect in 60 days upon enactment.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** Enactment of this legislation will have no impact on Commonwealth funds.
