SUMMARY: Extends the calibration testing cycle for non-radar speed timing devices and allows the Certificate of Accuracy to be completed electronically. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends Section 3368 (Speed timing devices) of Title 75 (Vehicle Code) to bring non-radar speed timing devices on a 1-year calibration cycle. The legislation also allows the certifying technician conducting the test on the equipment to complete the Certificate of Accuracy electronically on a form provided by PennDOT.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth or municipal funds.
