SUMMARY: Authorizes the conveyance of a permanent storm water drainage easement in Plymouth Borough, Luzerne County.

ANALYSIS: HB 2018 authorizes the Department of General Services (DGS), with the approval of the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs (DMVA), to convey to the Borough of Plymouth a permanent storm water drainage easement across approximately 0.525 acres of land owned by the Commonwealth at the Plymouth Readiness Center in Plymouth Borough, Luzerne County for \$1.00.

The purpose of the easement is to establish and maintain a storm water drainage easement to properly collect, convey and discharge upstream runoff into Coalbrook Creek to reduce flooding hazards downstream.

Terms and conditions of the conveyance are to be established through an easement agreement executed by DGS. In the event that the parties have not entered into an easement agreement within two years, the authorization will expire.

Effective date: 60 days

FISCAL IMPACT: The enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
