**SUMMARY:** Makes several traffic designations across the Commonwealth. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation makes the following traffic designations:

- A bridge on S.R. 2003 in Greene County as the Sheriff Brian A. Tennant Memorial Bridge;
- The interchange of S.R. 43, also known as the Mon-Fayette Expressway, with U.S. Route 40 in Fayette County as the PFC Joseph Frank Duda Memorial Interchange; and,
- The interchange of U.S. Route 40 with S.R. 4035 in Fayette County as the CPL Denny Ray Easter Memorial Interchange.

PennDOT and the Turnpike Commission shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying these designations to traffic in both directions.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge, highway, or interchange costs \$500. Since there are 3 designations in this legislation, the total cost will be about \$1,500. PennDOT will be responsible for \$1,000 and the Turnpike Commission \$500. Those costs can be absorbed within available funding.
