SUMMARY:

House Bill 2106 amends Act 233 of 1968, known as the Pennsylvania Fair Plan Act. It would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

House Bill 2106 amends Act 233 of 1968, known as the Pennsylvania Fair Plan Act, by repealing Article III, concerning the PA Civil Disorder Authority, and Article IV, concerning Basic Property Insurance Assessment.

Article III authorized the creation of the PA Civil Disorder Authority, however the Authority was never formed.

Article IV authorized a tax on basic property insurance to pay off bonds issued by the PA Civil Disorder Authority, but no bonds were issued so no tax was levied.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
