SUMMARY: House Bill 2219, Printer's Number 3950, adds a member to the Mining and Reclamation Advisory Board from the coal refuse energy and reclamation industry.

ANALYSIS: This bill amends Section 18(g) of the Surface Mining Conservation and Reclamation Act (Act 418 of 1945) to add an operator or employee of a coal refuse energy and reclamation facility as an additional member to the Mining and Reclamation Advisory Board. The new position on the board is contingent upon whether a coal refuse energy and reclamation facility is operating within the Commonwealth.

This legislation would take effect in 60 days upon enactment.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
