SUMMARY: Amends Act 320 of 1937, known as the Pennsylvania Election Code, to simplify notices that are required to be printed on absentee ballots and mail-in ballots. This legislation would take effect immediately.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends the Election Code to require the Secretary of the Commonwealth to prescribe the notice language printed on absentee and mail-in ballots for voters advising them that when their voted ballots are not timely received by the county on election day that they are permitted to vote at the appropriate polling place on election day only by provisional ballot unless the elector brings their absentee or mail-in ballot to their polling place, remits the ballot and the envelope containing the declaration of the elector to the judge of elections to be spoiled, and signs a statement to the same effect.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth or county funds.
