SUMMARY:

House Bill 2441 appropriates funding for the Pennsylvania State University. It would take effect on July 1, 2020 or immediately, whichever is later.

ANALYSIS:

This legislation appropriates funds to the Pennsylvania State University for the 2020-21 fiscal year. The appropriation for General Support receives \$242,096,000, the same amount it received in 2019-20. The appropriation for the Pennsylvania College of Technology receives \$26,736,000, the same amount it received in 2019-20. The bill also authorizes the appropriation of money contained within the Agricultural College Land Scrip Fund restricted receipt account for Agriculture Research and Extension Services. Funds provided for this account are appropriated as part of the General Appropriations Act.

FISCAL IMPACT:

A total amount of \$268,832,000 is provided in the following appropriations:

- For General Support, \$242,096,000;
- For Pennsylvania College of Technology, \$26,736,000.
