SUMMARY: Raises the population threshold where a borough elected official is allowed to serve as an employee of the borough. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends Section 1104 (Appointments and incompatible offices) of the Borough Code to increase the population of a borough from 3,000 people to 4,000 people where an elected official may work for such borough. The legislation also removes the reference to the 2010 census and changes it to the "most recent Federal decennial census".

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth or borough funds.
