SUMMARY: Senate Bill 273, Printer's Number 224, amends the Community-Based Health Care Act to remove the cap on funds which can be obtained by federally qualified health centers (FQHCs). This legislation would be effective in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation removes the limitation on the amount of grant funds available to FQHCs under the Community-Based Health Care Act. Currently, FQHCs can receive no more than 25% of the grant funds available.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation may impact the distribution of funds to grant recipients but will have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
