SUMMARY: Amends the Second Class Township Code to provide for reimbursement of newly elected Supervisors prior to officially taking office to attend any conference, institute, school or convention dealing with the duties and functions of their office. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends the Second Class Township Code to allow a Township's Board of Supervisors to authorize and reimburse a newly elected Supervisor, prior to officially taking office, to attend a conference, institute, school or convention dealing with the duties and functions of their elected office.

Reimbursement is limited to the registration fee, mileage for the use of a personal vehicle or reimbursement of actual transportation expenses, plus all other actual expenses that the Board of Supervisors agrees to pay. An itemized account of expenses incurred shall be submitted to the Board of Supervisors.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth or second class township funds.
