SUMMARY: Amends the Second Class Township Code changing the process for passage of the township's budget in the case of a revision to the proposed budget revenue or expenditures. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends the Second Class Township Code to require in the case of a revision to the township's proposed budget revenue or expenditures, by 10% in aggregate or 25% in any major category over the proposed budget, it must be advertised at least 10 days before adoption.

The legislation also removes the requirement that the budget be prepared on the forms furnished by the Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED).

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth or second class township funds.
