SUMMARY: Amends Section 1404(b) of the County Code relating to a vacancy in the office of the district attorney in a county of the fourth through eighth class. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation makes a technical change to clarify the requirements for the succession of the District Attorney (DA) by the first assistant district attorney (ADA) in counties of the fourth through eighth class. Section 1401(a) outlines certain qualifications an individual must satisfy in order to become a DA. The legislation amends Section 1404(b) to reflect that the first ADA must satisfy the qualifications of Section 1401(a) in order to be appointed as DA.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth or county funds.
