SUMMARY: Prohibits PennDOT from submitting applications for a veteran designation on a driver's license or ID card to the PA Department of Military and Veterans Affairs for review, approval or validation of veteran status. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends section 1510 (a.1) (related to veteran's driver's license designation) of Title 75 (Vehicle Code) to prohibit PennDOT from submitting a person's application documentation for the veteran designation to the PA Department of Military and Veterans Affairs (DMVA) for review, approval or validation. PennDOT must independently validate the applicant's documentation and issue to the veteran a driver's license or identification card displaying a veteran designation.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
