



# HOUSE COMMITTEE ON APPROPRIATIONS

## FISCAL NOTE

**SENATE BILL NO.** 1108

**PRIME SPONSOR:** Browne

**FUND:** COVID-19 Response Restricted Account

**SUMMARY:** Senate Bill 1108, printer's number 1730, makes supplemental appropriations to Act 1A of 2019, the 2019-2020 General Appropriations Act, from the COVID-19 Response Restricted Account to distribute federal funds received by the Commonwealth to address costs incurred due to the COVID-19 disaster emergency.

**ANALYSIS:** The bill provides federal supplemental appropriations to various Executive Branch departments to address program costs and financial burdens incurred by the Commonwealth during the COVID-19 pandemic. The appropriations shall be continuing appropriations and shall not lapse at the close of the 2019-2020 fiscal year.
