SUMMARY: Designates a bridge in Cambria County as the City of Johnstown Firefighters Memorial Bridge. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates the bridge, identified as Bridge Key 8680, carrying State Route 3055 over Stonycreek River in the City of Johnstown, Cambria County, as the City of Johnstown Firefighters Memorial Bridge.

The following Johnstown firefighters bravely gave their lives:

- 1. Jacob Graff, October 28, 1926;
- 2. Joseph Costanzo, October 1, 1951;
- 3. Thomas Potter, March 14, 1952;
- 4. John Brindle, January 8, 1954;
- 5. Robert Urbasik, May 17, 1958;
- 6. Richard Roberts, February 15, 1989;
- 7. John Slezak, March 18, 1989.

This bridge shall also commemorate any future fallen firefighters from the city of Johnstown's fire department.

PennDOT must erect and maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to traffic in both directions on the bridge.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of two signs, one in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. This cost can be absorbed in current allocated funds.
