SUMMARY: Designates a bridge in Cambria County as the Seaman 2nd Class Louis J. Benzie WWII Memorial Bridge. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates the bridge, identified as Bridge Key 8391, on that portion of Pennsylvania Route 53 over Laurel Run, also known as Lost Creek, in Dean Township, Cambria County, as the Seaman 2nd Class Louis J. Benzie WWII Memorial Bridge.

PennDOT must erect and maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to traffic in both directions on the bridge.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of two signs, one in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. This cost can be absorbed in current allocated funds.
